## What will Telethon do?...

The Hunter's Telethon will support five children's charities in their work with young people. Kaleidoscope—Hunter Children's Health Network, Hunter Life Education, Mission Australia, Newcastle Youth Service and the Starlight Foundation will use fundraised money for specific projects aimed at tackling some of the issues raised by Telethon. Issues like:

- Abuse
- Drug & alcohol problems
- Homelessness
- Self-esteem
- Family breakdown

Here at Kaleidoscope, funds donated from NBN Telethon will be used to build a centre for high-risk mothers and their children. It will focus on prevention, addressing potential problems early in a child's life. If funding permits, a second project would see the development of a youth outreach bus service to take
